

Special regulations for course enrollment

1. Special regulations for enrolled students

(1) Students enrolled in academic year 2012, they must acquire 22 credits in total before graduation.

- Chinese Literature-4 credits.
- General Education Curriculum covers 4 major areas, namely **"Humanities", "Art", "Social Sciences" and "Nature"**. For each major areas course, students must acquire at least 2 credits.
- Both of the core course and the elective courses all confess to as General Education Curriculum.

(2) Students enrolled after academic year 2012, they must acquire 22 credits in total before graduation.

- General Education Curriculum covers 6 dimensions, namely **"Self-Exploration", "Cultural Connotation", "Art Appreciation", "Social Learning", "Biology and Health Care" and "Science Exploration"**.
- Core courses-12 credits required in total.
For each dimensions course, students must acquire at least 2 credits.
- Elective courses-10 credits required in total.
Students can be freely chosen elective courses, at least 10 credits required in total.

2. Each student can take no more than three general education courses in any given semester (including required core courses).
3. Under extenuating circumstances, each student wishing to exceed the limit of three-courses needs to seek department assistant to do a favor to file an application. If the application for credit overload is accepted by related person, the student can take more than three courses.
